


WHEREAS, William D. Dyke, Mayor of the City of Madison, has informed me that a rally to be held today, January 27, 1971, represents a threat to the security of state owned property in the area of the University of Wisconsin campus; and

WHEREAS, I hereby determine that this proposed rally represents a threat to the security of state owned property; and

WHEREAS, Mayor Dyke has requested that I have twenty-five (25) State Highway Patrolmen assigned to the University of Wisconsin campus area pursuant to powers vested in me by Wis. Stats. §22.165;

NOW, THEREFORE, I hereby authorize and request that twenty-five (25) members of the Wisconsin State Highway Patrol be assigned to the area of the University of Wisconsin campus to protect state property in that vicinity during the pendency of the threat to state property on Wednesday, January 27, 1971.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Wisconsin to be affixed. Done at the Capitol in the City of Madison this 27th day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand nine-hundred and seventy-one.
