

EXECUTIVE ORDER #34

WHEREAS, the forests of Wisconsin are a valuable recreational, educational, aesthetic and economic resource; and

WHEREAS, the Management of this valuable resource must reflect the need for preservation of our forests for the enjoyment and education of present and future generations; and

WHEREAS, the economic value of state forest resources must not predominate the need for preservation of our forests for their recreational, educational and aesthetic values; and

WHEREAS, Wisconsin's timber management policies should be periodically re-examined and updated.



THE COMMITTEE TO REVIEW TIMBER MANAGEMENT
POLICIES ON STATE OWNED LANDS
