

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 54

WHEREAS, people with disabilities daily encounter physical and psychological barriers to their full participation in community life; and

WHEREAS, the existence of such barriers deprives them of their inherent rights and deprives the community of the contributions these citizens can make;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, PATRICK J. LUCEY, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, do hereby establish the

GOVERNOR'S TASK FORCE ON PROBLEMS OF PEOPLE WITH PHYSICAL HANDICAPS

The Task Force is charged with studying areas such as transportation, housing, employment, consumer affairs, education, rehabilitation, and recreation, as they affect persons with handicaps, and with preparing a report which details the barriers they encounter and outlines practical recommendations for action to eliminate those barriers; thereby, assuring Wisconsin citizens with handicaps the full enjoyment of their civil rights.
