EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 75

WHEREAS, a public disaster resulting from a tornado has occurred in the City of Oshkosh and Winnebago County causing damage to property and threatening the safety and health of the populace,


NOW, THEREFORE, I, ROBERT C. ZIMMERMAN, Acting Governor of the State of Wisconsin, do hereby declare a

STATE OF EMERGENCY

to exist in the City of Oshkosh and Winnebago County, Wisconsin, beginning as of 7:00 p.m., April 21, 1974, and continuing until the danger to public health, welfare and safety is abated.

FURTHER, under the authority contained in Section 21.11 of the Wisconsin Statutes, I hereby order into State service sufficient men and equipment of the Wisconsin National Guard as re necessary to assist the civil authorities of the City of Oshkosh and Winnebago County in the performance of their duties during this state of emergency.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Wisconsin to be affixed. Done at the Capitol in the City of Madison, this twenty-first day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-four.
