





EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 11

WHEREAS, a vacancy exists in the office of Member of the Assembly from the Tenth Assembly District caused by the resignation of the office of State Assemblyman by F. James Sensenbrenner, Jr., on the 8th day of April, 1975, whose term of office would have expired on the first Monday in January, 1977.


NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARTIN J. SCHREIBER, Acting Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by virtue of the authority vested in me pursuant to Section 8.50, Wisconsin Statutes, do hereby order that a Special Election be held in the Tenth Assembly District of the State of Wisconsin on the 29 day of July, 1975, to fill said vacancy, and that circulation of nomination papers may commence this day and the deadline for filing nomination papers for partisan candidates will be 5:00 p.m., June 13, 1975, and the deadline for filing nomination papers for independent candidates will be 5:00 p.m., on July 8. Said Special Election shall be noticed, held, conducted, canvassed, and returned in accordance with law.
