



**EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT**

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 17


WHEREAS, a vacancy exists in the office of Member of the Assembly from the Eightieth Assembly District because of the death of State Representative Kenyon E. Giese on the 14th day of August, 1975, whose term of office would have expired on the first Monday in January, 1977.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, PATRICK J. LUCEY, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by virtue of the authority vested in me by Section 8.50, Wisconsin Statutes, do hereby order that a Special Election be held in the Eightieth Assembly District of the State of Wisconsin, encompassing parts of Sauk County and Columbia County, on the 4th day of November, 1975, to fill said vacancy; that the circulation of nomination papers may commence this day for partisan candidates and on September 23, 1975, for independent candidates; and that the deadline for filing nomination papers for partisan candidates will be 5:00 p.m., September 19, 1975, and the deadline for filing nomination papers for independent candidates will be 5:00 p.m., October 14, 1975. Said Special Election shall be noticed, held, conducted, canvassed, and returned in accordance with law.
