


EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 3

WHEREAS, a vacancy exists in the office of Member of the Senate from the Twenty-Second Senatorial District caused by the resignation of the office of State Senator by Douglas LaFollette, on the 6th day of January, A.D., 1975, whose term of office would have expired on the first Monday in January, A.D., 1977;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, PATRICK J. LUCEY, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by virtue of the authority vested in me pursuant to Section 8.50, Wis. Stats., do hereby order that a Special Election be held in the Twenty-Second Senatorial District of the State of Wisconsin on the first day of April, 1975, to fill said vacancy, that the Special Election be held to coincide with the Spring Election on the first day of April, A.D., 1975, and that said Special Election and Spring Election shall be noticed, held, conducted, canvassed, and returned in accordance with law. Circulation of nomination papers may commence this day and the deadline for filing nomination papers for partisan candidates will be 5:00 p.m., January 31, 1975, and the deadline for filing nomination papers for independent candidates will be 5:00 p.m. on February 25, 1975.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Wisconsin to be affixed. Done at the Capitol in the City of Madison, this 9th day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-five.
