

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 25

WHEREAS, a vacancy exists in the office of Member of the Assembly from the Forty-Eighth Assembly District because of the resignation of State Representative Lewis T. Mittness on the 16th of December, 1975, whose term of office would have expired on the first Monday in January, 1977.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, PATRICK J. LUCEY, Governor the the State of Wisconsin, by virtue of the authority vested in me by Section 8.50, Wisconsin Statutes, do hereby order that a Special Election be held in the Forty-Eighth Assembly District of the State of Wisconsin, encompassing parts of Rock County, on the 6th day of April, 1976, to fill said vacancy; that the circulation of nomination papers may commence this day for partisan candidates and on February 3, 1976, for independent candidates; and that the deadline for filing nomination papers for partisan candidates will be 5:00 p.m., January 30, 1976, and the deadline for filing nomination papers for independent candidates will be 5:00 p.m., February 24, 1976. Said Special Election shall be noticed, held, conducted, canvassed, and returned in accordance with law.
