


EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 32


WHEREAS, a vacancy exists in the office of State Senator from the Eleventh Senate District because of the resignation of State Senator Wayne F. Whittow on April 30, 1976, whose term of office would have expired on the first Monday in January, 1979.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, PATRICK J. LUCEY, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by virtue of the authority vested in me by Section 8.50, Wisconsin Statutes, as amended, do hereby order that, to fill said vacancy, a Special Election be held in the Eleventh Senate District of the State of Wisconsin, encompassing parts of Milwaukee County, on November 2, 1976. The circulation of nomination papers for partisan and independent candidates may commence on June 1, 1976. The deadline for filing nomination papers for partisan and independent candidates shall be 5:00 p.m., July 13, 1976. The Special Primary shall be held on September 14, 1976, the same date as the general primary. The Special Election shall be held on November 2, 1976, the same date as the general election. Said Special Election shall be noticed, held, conducted, canvassed and returned in accordance with law.
