EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 46

WHEREAS, a vacancy exists in the office of State Representative from the 30th Assembly District because of the resignation of Michael P. Early, effective August 16, 1977, whose term of office would have expired on the first Monday in January, 1979.


NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARTIN J. SCHREIBER, Acting Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by virtue of the authority vested in me by Section 8.50, Wisconsin Statutes, as amended, do hereby order that, to fill said vacancy, a Special Election be held in the 30th Assembly District in the State of Wisconsin, encompassing the entirety of Buffalo County and Pepin County, and those parts of Pierce County and Trempealeau County particularly described in Section 4.10 (3) (c) and (d), Wisconsin Statutes, on October 25, 1977. The circulation of nomination papers for partisan and independent candidates may commence on August 19, 1977. The deadline for filing nomination papers for partisan and independent candidates shall be 5:00 p.m., September 9, 1977. The Special Primary shall be held on September 27, 1977. The Special Election shall be held on October 25, 1977. Said Special Election shall be noticed, held, conducted, canvassed and returned in accordance with law.
