





EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 51

WHEREAS, a vacancy exists in the office of State Representative from the 16th Assembly District because of the resignation of Michael H. Elconin, effective November 14, 1977, whose term of office would have expired on the first Monday in January, 1979.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARTIN J. SCHREIBER, Acting Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by virtue of the authority vested in me by Section 8.50, Wisconsin Statutes, as amended, do hereby order that, to fill said vacancy a Special Election be held in the 16th Assembly District in the State of Wisconsin, encompassing that part of the City of Milwaukee as particularly described in Section 4.06(1), Wisconsin Statutes, on January 17, 1978. The circulation of nominating papers for partisan and independent candidates may commence on November 18, 1977. The deadline for filing nomination papers for partisan and independent candidates shall be 5:00 p.m., December 2, 1977. The Special Primary shall be held on December 20, 1977. The Special Election shall be held on January 17, 1978. Said Special Election shall be noticed, held, conducted, canvassed, and returned in accordance with law.


