



EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 58

WHEREAS, a natural disaster caused by severe weather during the period of June 29 through July 2, 1978, has occurred and is occurring in the State of Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS, such severe weather has created and is creating emergencies relating to the safety and welfare of the people of the State of Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS, the following counties are affected as a result of this severe weather:

Buffalo, Crawford, Dane, Dunn, Green, Iowa, Juneau, LaCrosse, Lafayette, Monroe, Pierce, Richland, Rock, Sauk and Vernon

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARTIN J. SCHREIBER, Acting Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the virtue of the authority vested in me by Section 22.16(3)(b)(1), Wisconsin Statutes, do hereby proclaim and declare that a

STATE OF EMERGENCY

exists in the above said Wisconsin counties.

PURSUANT TO said STATE OF EMERGENCY, I hereby declare my intent to exercise the authority vested in me by Section 22.16(3)(b)(5), Wisconsin Statutes, in issuing such orders as I deem necessary for the security of persons and property.



IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Wisconsin to be affixed. Done at the Capitol in the City of Madison this second day of July in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-eight.
