
EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 21

WHEREAS, a vacancy exists in the office of State Representative from the 91st Assembly District because of the resignation of Steve Gunderson whose term of office would have expired on the first Monday in January, 1981;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LEE SHERMAN DREYFUS, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by virtue of the authority vested in me by Section 8.50, Wisconsin Statutes, do hereby order that, to fill the existing vacancy, a Special Election be held on September 18, 1979, in the 91st Assembly District, consisting of parts of Clark, Jackson, Trempeleau, Chippewa, and Eau Claire Counties, as described in Section 4.31(1), Wisconsin Statutes.

AND, the circulation of nominating papers for partisan and independent candidates may commence on July 16, 1979; the deadline for filing nomination papers for partisan and independent candidates shall be 5:00 P.M., July 31, 1979. The special primary shall be held on August 21, 1979. The election shall be noticed, held, conducted, canvassed, and returned in accordance with law.
