EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 29

WHEREAS, a vacancy exists in the office of State Representative from the 39th Assembly District, because of the death of State Representative Milton Lorman on November 27, 1979, whose term of office would have expired on the first Monday in January, 1981;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LEE SHERMAN DREYFUS, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by virtue of the authority vested in me by Section 8.50, Wisconsin Statutes, do hereby order that a Special Election, to fill the existing vacancy, be held on January 31, 1980, in the 39th Assembly District, consisting of parts of Jefferson and Walworth Counties, as described in Section 4.13(3), Wisconsin Statutes.

AND, the circulation of nominating papers for partisan and independent candidates may commence on December 3, 1979; the deadline for filing nomination papers for partisan and independent candidates shall be 5:00 P.M., December 13, 1979. The special primary shall be held on January 3, 1980. The election shall be noticed, held, conducted, canvassed, and returned in accordance with the law.
