EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 9

WHEREAS, Section 14.019, Wisconsin Statutes, provides that under the general powers of the Executive Office the Governor may create and abolish non-statutory committees; and

WHEREAS, said Section provides that any non-statutory committee shall expire on the fourth Monday of January of the year in which a new gubernatorial term of office begins, unless the new Governor, by Executive Order, provides for its continued existence; and

WHEREAS, persons now serving on such committees remain members until they resign or until they are removed or replaced by action of the Governor; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 4, issued January 22, 1979 pursuant to the provisions of Section 14.019, Wisconsin Statutes, provided for the continued existence of several specific non-statutory entities created in accordance with the provisions of said Section, including Executive Order No. 50, issued October 24, 1977 and relating to state and federal legislation governing the operation of existing manpower training and employment programs, said entities to remain in effect until April 1, 1979;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LEE SHERMAN DREYFUS, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, pursuant to the provisions of Section 14.019, Wisconsin Statutes, do hereby provide for the further continuation of Executive Order No. 50, as continued by Executive Order No. 4, said entity to remain in effect until April 30, 1979.
