EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 49

WHEREAS, severe weather, particularly high winds and tornadoes have occurred in the State of Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, such severe weather has endangered the safety and well-being of the affected citizens of this state; and

WHEREAS, such severe weather has created hardship and undue suffering for the affected citizens; and

WHEREAS, Eau Claire, Chippewa, Pierce and Dunn Counties have been affected by such severe weather;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LEE SHERMAN DREYFUS, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by virtue of the authority vested in me by Section 22.16(3)(b)(1), Wisconsin Statutes, do hereby proclaim that a

STATE OF EMERGENCY

exists in the above enumerated counties of this state; and

PURSUANT TO said STATE OF EMERGENCY, I hereby declare my intent to exercise the authority vested in me by Section 22.16(3)(b)(5), Wisconsin Statutes, to issue such orders as I deem necessary for the security of persons and property;

AND, I do hereby direct the State Division of Emergency Government, the Wisconsin National Guard, the Wisconsin State Patrol, the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources and other appropriate local and state government agencies to take whatever actions are necessary to ensure the safety and well-being of the affected citizens and to alleviate undue suffering and loss.
