EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 71

WHEREAS, a vacancy exists in the office of the Municipal Judge for the Village of Coon Valley, in the county of Vernon, State of Wisconsin, as a result of the fact that Dale Nelson, the incumbent municipal judge and the person who received the largest number of votes for municipal judge in the last election, refused to serve;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, LEE SHERMAN DREYFUS, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by virtue of the authority vested in me by Section 8.50, Wisconsin Statutes, do hereby order that a Special Election, to fill the existing vacancy, be held.

IF, nomination for such office is to be accomplished by the circulation of nomination papers, then the Special Election shall be held on July 21, 1981. The circulation of nominating papers for candidates may commence on May 7, 1981, the deadline for filing nomination papers for candidates shall be 5:00 P.M., May 26, 1981. The special primary shall be held on June 23, 1981.

IF, nomination for such office is to be accomplished by the holding of a nominating caucus, then the nominating caucus shall be held in accordance with Section 8.05(1) of the Wisconsin Statutes on or before May 22, 1981, and the Special Election shall be held on July 21, 1981.

AND, the election shall be noticed, held, conducted, canvassed, and returned in accordance with the law.
