





EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 86

WHEREAS, a vacancy exists in the office of the State Representative from the 16th Assembly District as a result of the resignation of William Broydrick, whose term of office would have expired on the first Monday in January, 1983;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LEE SHERMAN DREYFUS, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by virtue of the authority vested in me by Section 8.50, Wisconsin Statutes, do hereby order that a Special Election, to fill the vacancy, be held on January 12, 1982 in the 16th Assembly District, consisting of part of Milwaukee County, as described in Section 4.06(1), Wisconsin Statutes.

AND, the circulation of nominating papers for partisan and independent candidates may commence on November 6, 1982; the deadline for filing nomination papers for partisan and independent candidates shall be 5:00 p.m., November 17, 1981. The special primary shall be held on December 15, 1981. The election shall be noticed, held, conducted, canvassed and returned in accordance with the law.
