



EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2

WHEREAS, a vacancy exists in the office of State Senator from the 12th Senate District, due to the resignation of State Senator Clifford W. Krueger on January 3, 1983, whose term of office would have expired on the first Monday in January of 1985;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ANTHONY S. EARL, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority given me by Chapter 1, Laws of 1983, do hereby order that a Special Election to fill the vacancy be held on April 5, 1983, and a Special Primary on February 15, 1983 in the 12th Senate District as described in the order issued by the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Wisconsin on June 17, 1982 in the case of The Wisconsin State AFL-CIO, et al. v. Elections Board, et al., Civil Action 82-C-0113.

AND, the circulation of nomination papers for partisan and independent candidates may commence on January 7, 1983 and said nomination papers may be filed no later than 5:00 p.m. January 18, 1983. The election shall be noticed, held, conducted, canvassed and returned in accordance with the law.
