




EXECUTIVE ORDER 46

WHEREAS, a vacancy exists in the office of municipal judge for the Village of Paddock Lake due to the resignation of Judge Eithel Smith whose term of office would have expired on May 1, 1985;

NOW, THEREFORE, I Anthony S. Earl, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, pursuant to Wis. Stats. § 8.50 and 755.01(1), do order that a special election to fill the vacancy be held on Tuesday, April 17, 1984 and a special primary, if necessary, be held on March 20, 1984 in the Village of Paddock Lake. Nomination papers may be circulated on and after the date of this order and must be filed no later than 5:00 p.m. on February 20, 1984. The election shall be noticed, held, conducted, canvassed and returned in accordance with the law.
