

EXECUTIVE ORDER 51

WHEREAS, a vacancy exists in the office of municipal judge for the City of Stoughton due to the resignation of Judge Carl G. Pieper whose term of office would have expired on May 1, 1986;

NOW, THEREFORE, I Anthony S. Earl, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, pursuant to Wis. Stats. § 8.50 and 755.01(1), do order that a special election to fill the vacancy be held on July 10, 1984 and a special primary, if necessary, be held on June 12, 1984 in the City of Stoughton. Nomination papers may be circulated on and after the date of this order and must be filed no later than 5:00 p.m. on May 24, 1984. The election shall be noticed, held, conducted, canvassed and returned in accordance with the law.
