


# The State of Wisconsin



## EXECUTIVE ORDER 57(A)

WHEREAS, severe weather, particularly high winds and tornadoes have occurred in the State of Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, such severe weather has endangered the safety and well-being of the affected citizens of this state, causing hardship and suffering for them, and

WHEREAS, the counties of Iowa, Dane, Dodge and Columbia have been especially affected by such severe weather;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Anthony S. Earl, Governor of Wisconsin, by the authority granted


the Wisconsin National Guard, the Wisconsin State Patrol, the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources, the Department of Health and Social Services and other appropriate state and local government agencies to take whatever actions are necessary to ensure the safety and well-being of the affected citizens and to alleviate their suffering and loss.
