



## EXECUTIVE ORDER 60

WHEREAS, a vacancy exists in the office of municipal judge for the Village of Lena due to the death of Judge Robert McNurlen whose term of office would have expired on May 1, 1986;

NOW, THEREFORE, I James T. Flynn, Acting Governor of the State of Wisconsin, pursuant to Wis. Stats. § 8.50 and 755.01(1), do order that a special election to fill the vacancy be held on November 6, 1984 and a special primary, if necessary, be held on September 11, 1984 in the Village of Lena. Nomination papers may be circulated on and after the date of this order and must be filed no later than 5:00 p.m. on July 10, 1984. The election shall be noticed, held, conducted, canvassed and returned in accordance with the law.
