EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 65

WHEREAS, the state of Wisconsin wishes to demonstrate its respect and concern for minorities, including Asians, and to highlight their unique role as citizens of this state; and

WHEREAS, there is a particular need to increase the Governor's Advisory Council on Asians from a ten member council to a sixteen member committee;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ANTHONY S. EARL, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, do order that the Governor's Advisory Council on Asians shall consist of sixteen members, to be appointed by the Governor to serve at his pleasure.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have here-unto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Wisconsin to be affixed. Done at the Capitol in the City of Madison this eleventh day of September in the year of Our Lord, one thousand nine hundred eighty-four.
