
EXECUTIVE ORDER #76

WHEREAS, severe weather, particularly high winds and tornadoes occurred in the State of Wisconsin on June 8, 1985; and

WHEREAS, such severe weather has endangered the safety and well-being of the affected citizens of this state, causing hardship and suffering for them; and

WHEREAS, the counties of Oneida and Price have been especially affected by such severe weather;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ANTHONY S. EARL, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority granted me by Wis. Stats. S. 166.03 (b), declare a state of emergency exists in the counties of Oneida and Price and direct the State Division of Emergency Government, the Wisconsin National Guard, the Wisconsin State Patrol, the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources, the Department of Health and Social Services and other appropriate state and local government agencies to take whatever actions are necessary to ensure the safety and well-being of the affected citizens and to alleviate their suffering and loss.
