

### EXECUTIVE ORDER 90

WHEREAS, a vacancy exists in the office of municipal judge for the City of Milwaukee due to the resignation of Judge Christopher R. Foley whose term of office would have expired on May 1, 1987;


NOW, THEREFORE, I Anthony S. Earl, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, pursuant to Wis. Stats. § 8.50 and 755.01(1), do order that a special election to fill the vacancy be held on April 1, 1986 and a special primary, if necessary, be held on February 18, 1986 in the City of Milwaukee. Nomination papers may be circulated on and after the date of this order and must be filed no later than 5:00 p.m. on January 14, 1986. The election shall be noticed, held, conducted, canvassed and returned in accordance with the law.
