



EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 106

I, Anthony S. Earl, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, pursuant to section 11 of Article IV and section 4 of Article V of the Constitution of Wisconsin, require the convening of a special session of the Legislature at the Capitol in Madison, beginning on July 15, 1986 at 10:00 a.m. solely to consider and act upon the following specific legislative business:

1. Making program trainee compensation an eligible cost of a labor training program and making an appropriation to fund labor training grants.
