EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 109

WHEREAS, floods occurred in the State of Wisconsin on August 6, 1986, endangering the safety and well-being of the affected citizens of this state, causing hardship and suffering for them; and

WHEREAS, the county of Milwaukee has been especially affected by the severe weather;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ANTHONY S. EARL, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority granted me by Wis. Stats. § 166.03 (b), declare a state of emergency exists in the county of Milwaukee and direct the State Division of Emergency Government, the State Patrol, the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources, the Department of Health and Social Services, and other appropriate state and local government agencies to take whatever actions are necessary to ensure the safety and well-being of the affected citizens and to alleviate their suffering and loss.
