
EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 119


WHEREAS, Executive Order 104, dated June 26, 1986 promulgated criteria upon which state employees self-identify and are counted as American Indians and provided for recognition of a person as a tribal member for state affirmative action purposes and that provision is inadequate.

I, Anthony S. Earl, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, pursuant to Article V, §§1 and 5 of the Wisconsin Constitution and Wis. Stats. Chapter 230 amend Executive Order 104 as follows:

In item 3., delete "a member" and substitute "an American Indian".
