
EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 97


(REVISION OF PRIOR ORDER)

I, Anthony S. Earl, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, pursuant to section 11 of Article IV and section 4 of Article V of the Constitution of Wisconsin, do amend as follows Executive Order 95, as amended by Executive Order 96, dated March 21, 1986 requiring the convening of a special session of the Legislature at the Capitol in Madison, beginning on March 24, 1986 at 1:30 p.m.:

1. Add a paragraph 14, to read as follows: Authorizing the Departments of Natural Resources and of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection, with the prior approval of the Department of Natural Resources, to grant to institutions of higher education and nonprofit organizations exemptions from certain statutes and administrative rules, not including those having to do with toxic and hazardous wastes, to facilitate research relating to nonpoint source pollution control; and requiring the departments to promulgate emergency and permanent rules establishing the procedure for granting exemptions.


