EXECUTIVE ORDER #19


WHEREAS, State Representative Richard P. Matty was re-elected on November 4, 1986 to represent the Eighty-Eighth Assembly District; and

WHEREAS, State Representative Richard P. Matty has notified the Governor that he will resign as State Representative from the Eighty-Eighth District, effective August 4, 1987;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, pursuant to Wis. Stats. §§ 8.50 (1)(a) and 4(d), order that a special election be held on October 6, 1987 to fill the vacancy in the Eighty-Eighth Assembly District, as described in Wis. Stats. § 4.88, for a term expiring the day preceding the first Monday in January, 1989, and that if a primary is necessary, it be held on September 8, 1987. Circulation of nomination papers for candidates may begin on the date of this order and nomination papers may be filed no later than 5:00 p.m., August 11, 1987. The election shall be held, conducted, canvassed and returned in accordance with law.
