EXECUTIVE ORDER #21

Directing the Wisconsin Department of Revenue
to Withdraw from the Great Lakes Interstate Sales Compact


WHEREAS, the Wisconsin Department of Revenue executed the Great Lakes Interstate Sales Compact with the tax administration agencies of the states of Illinois, Indiana, Michigan, Minnesota and Ohio on July 16, 1986; and

WHEREAS, in my veto message to the Legislature on SB 100 (Wisconsin Act 27), I indicated that I would issue an Executive Order directing that Wisconsin withdraw from this agreement;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, do hereby order the Wisconsin Department of Revenue to withdraw from the Great Lakes Interstate Sales Compact.
