EXECUTIVE ORDER #25


WHEREAS, State Representative James R. Charneski was elected on June 9, 1987 to represent the Sixth Assembly District; and

WHEREAS, State Representative James R. Charneski has notified the Governor that he will resign as State Representative from the Sixth District, effective September 2, 1987;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, pursuant to Wis. Stats. §§ 8.50 (1)(a) and 4(d), order that a special election be held on December 8, 1987 to fill the vacancy in the Sixth Assembly District, as described in Wis. Stats. § 4.06, for a term expiring the day preceding the first Monday in January, 1989, and that if a primary is necessary, it be held on November 10, 1987. Circulation of nomination papers for candidates may begin on the date of this order and nomination papers may be filed no later than 5:00 p.m., October 13, 1987. The election shall be held, conducted, canvassed and returned in accordance with law.
