EXECUTIVE ORDER #66

Relating to transfer of Nuclear Medicine Service to
University of Wisconsin Hospital and Clinics

WHEREAS, nearly all necessary nuclear medicine service has been provided to University of Wisconsin Hospital and Clinics (UWHC) patients by the adjoining Middleton Veterans Administration Hospital (MVAH) since UWHC's move to the Clinical Science Center in 1979; and

WHEREAS, UWHC will re-establish a complete nuclear medicine service at the Clinical Science Center for academic and cost containment reasons; and

WHEREAS, there is a shortage of qualified nuclear medicine technicians; and

WHEREAS, the individuals working in the nuclear medicine service were and continue to be under the direction of UWHC faculty while employed at the MVAH; and

WHEREAS, the transfer of the nuclear medicine service staff would provide a smooth transition and uninterrupted high quality patient care;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of this State, and specifically by Wisconsin Statute section 111.93(3), and more specifically by the contract between the State of Wisconsin and the Wisconsin State Employees union in Article V, Section 1, do hereby direct that:

All employees of the Veterans Administration Hospital Nuclear Medicine Section who are approved by the Department of Employment Relations for accretion into the classified service shall be given seniority based on their service with the Veterans Administration.
