EXECUTIVE ORDER #67

Relating to a Special Session of the Legislature.

I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, pursuant to Article IV, section 11 and Article V, section 4 of the Constitution of Wisconsin do require the convening of a special session of the Legislature at the Capitol in Madison, beginning on Tuesday, October 10, 1989 at 10:00 a.m. solely to consider legislation regarding illicit drug use and alcohol abuse in the following subject areas:

- (1) Legislation relating to law enforcement and criminal justice initiatives.
- (2) Legislation relating to expansion of correctional facilities.
- (3) Legislation related to correctional programs targeted toward drug users.
- (4) Legislation related to various sanctions for drug-related abuses, including but not limited to restriction of driving privileges, and confiscation of assets.
- (5) Legislation related to treatment of drug and alcohol users and prevention of drug and alcohol abuse.
- (6) Legislation related to expansion of media/education efforts and community involvement/assistance efforts.
