EXECUTIVE ORDER #68

Relating to a Special Election for the
Fifth State Senate District

STATE DOCUMENT

MADISON, WIS., 53702

WHEREAS, State Senator Mordecai Lee submitted his resignation as a State Senator for the Fifth Senate District, effective September 1, 1989,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, pursuant to Wisconsin Statute section 8.50 order that a special election be held on December 12, 1989 to fill the vacancy in the Fifth Senate District as described in Wis. Stats. s.4.009 (5) for a term expiring the day preceding the first Monday in January, 1991, and that if a primary is necessary, it be held on November 14, 1989. Circulation of nomination papers for candidates may begin on the date of this order and nomination papers may be filed no later than 5:00 p.m., October 17, 1989. This section shall be held, conducted, canvassed and returned in accordance with law.
