### EXECUTIVE ORDER #100


Relating to the creation of the Governor's Council on Natural Resources in Northern Wisconsin

WHEREAS, Wisconsin's natural resources are a source of great pride for its residents; and

WHEREAS, Wisconsin's natural resources must be managed properly to ensure their availability for our residents and non-residents alike;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of this State, and specifically by Wisconsin Statute section 14.019, do hereby:

1. Establish the Governor's Council on Natural Resources in Northern Wisconsin ("the Council").
2. Provide that the membership of the Council shall not exceed eighteen (18) members, appointed by the Governor to serve at his pleasure. A chairperson shall be appointed by the Governor from among the members, and shall serve at his pleasure.
3. Provide that the Governor shall choose an Executive Secretary of the Council, to serve at his pleasure.
4. Direct the Council to study and recommend to the Governor and the Department of Natural Resources Board policies and practices to properly manage and utilize, and ensure the availability of, the natural resources in northern Wisconsin for the residents of Wisconsin.
5. Provide that staffing for the Council be provided by the Departments of Administration and Natural Resources.
6. Direct the Secretary of the Department of Administration to provide the Council with sums of money that are necessary and proper for the legitimate travel expenses of Council members under Section 20.505(3)(a) of the Wisconsin Statutes.
