EXECUTIVE ORDER #107


WHEREAS, a major storm system has delivered significant amounts of snow, together with high winds; and

WHEREAS, the safety of state employees may be affected by these severe weather conditions;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of this State, and specifically by Wisconsin Statutes s. 230.35(5)(c), do hereby order all offices and other work stations of the departments of state government affected by this storm, other than the University of Wisconsin System, be closed at 9 a.m. this day, except for those offices or work stations containing essential personnel.
