EXECUTIVE ORDER #80

Relating to Creation of the Governor's Advisory Committee
on Recreational Business Development

WHEREAS, tourism is an important industry to Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS, the ability of recreational business to provide accommodations to tourists is critical in maintaining and extending tourism development across this state; and

WHEREAS, recreational business development is an important priority of this administration;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of this State, and specifically by Wisconsin Statute section 14.019, do hereby:

1. Establish the Governor's Advisory Committee on Recreational Business Development ("the Committee").
2. Provide the membership of the Committee be composed of eight members appointed by the Governor, to serve at his pleasure.
3. Direct the Committee to advise the Governor and the Department of Development, Division of Tourism Development on issues related to recreational business concerns and development opportunities.
4. Provide that staffing and expenses of the Committee be provided by the Department of Development.
