## EXECUTIVE ORDER #111

Relating to creation of the Governor's Councils on African American, Asian, Hispanic and Urban Indian Affairs

WHEREAS, the State of Wisconsin has an obligation to promote equality of opportunity for all its people; and

WHEREAS, state government could benefit from the advice of people who are knowledgeable and experienced with regard to the impact of state policies on minority groups and methods by which its service to these citizens could be improved;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and Laws of the State of Wisconsin, and by Wisconsin Statute s. 14.019, do hereby establish

THE GOVERNOR'S COUNCIL ON AFRICAN AMERICAN AFFAIRS
THE GOVERNOR'S COUNCIL ON ASIAN AFFAIRS
THE GOVERNOR'S COUNCIL ON HISPANIC AFFAIRS
THE GOVERNOR'S COUNCIL ON URBAN INDIAN AFFAIRS

- Each Council shall consist of not more than nine (9) members appointed by the Governor, to serve at his pleasure. The Chair of each Council shall be appointed by the Governor.
- Each Council shall develop positions relative to the issues concerning their community, make recommendations to the Governor and develop strategies to implement position(s) taken on the identified issues.
- 3) Whenever appropriate, the Councils shall coordinate their activities with those of other state agencies and departments to prevent any duplication of effort in areas of mutual concern.
- Staff assistance for each Council shall be arranged through the Governor's Office in Milwaukee.
- 5) The Secretary of the Department of Administration shall provide each Council with sums of money that are necessary and proper for the legitimate travel expenses of Council members under Wis. Stats. § 20.505 (3)(a).
