
EXECUTIVE ORDER #128

Relating to a Special Election for the  
Thirty-second State Assembly District

WHEREAS, State Representative Joseph Wimmer has resigned as a State Representative for the Thirty-second Assembly District effective November 11, 1991;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, pursuant to Wisconsin Statute § 8.50 order that a special election be held on November 12, 1991 to fill the vacancy in the Thirty-second Assembly District as described in Wis. Stats. § 4.32 for a term expiring the day preceding the first Monday in January, 1993, and that if a primary is necessary, it be held on October 15, 1991. Circulation of nomination papers for candidates may begin on the date of this order and nomination papers may be filed no later than 5:00 p.m., September 17, 1991. This election shall be held, conducted, canvassed and returned in accordance with law.
