EXECUTIVE ORDER #129

Relating to repealing Executive Order #128

WHEREAS, Executive Order #128 was issued on September 11, 1991 for the purpose of calling a special election to fill a vacancy in the office of the state representative in the Thirty-second State Assembly District because of the resignation of State Representative Joseph Wimmer to accept an appointment to the circuit court; and

WHEREAS, questions have been raised as to whether a special election can be called in anticipation of a vacancy when a member of the legislature is appointed to another office or only when a member is elected to another office;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of this State, do hereby repeal Executive Order #128 (dated September 11, 1991). The election will be re-called when the vacancy occurs.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Wisconsin to be affixed. Done at the Capitol in the City of Madison this sixteenth day of September in the year one thousand nine hundred and ninety-one.




