EXECUTIVE ORDER #130

Relating to a Special Election for the
Eighty-sixth State Assembly District

WHEREAS, State Representative Brad Zweck has resigned as a State Representative for the Eighty-sixth Assembly District effective September 16, 1991;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, pursuant to Wisconsin Statute § 8.50 order that a special election be held on November 19, 1991 to fill the vacancy in the Eighty-sixth Assembly District as described in Wis. Stats. § 4.86 for a term expiring the day preceding the first Monday in January, 1993, and that if a primary is necessary, it be held on October 22, 1991. Circulation of nomination papers for candidates may begin on the date of this order and nomination papers may be filed no later than 5:00 p.m., September 24, 1991. This election shall be held, conducted, canvassed and returned in accordance with law.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Wisconsin to be affixed. Done at the Capitol in the City of Madison this eighteenth day of September in the year one thousand nine hundred and ninety-one.


