





EXECUTIVE ORDER #153

Relating to amending Executive Order #147 (dated 6/18/92)
to expand the scope of the Governor's Commission on Dental Care

I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of this State, and specifically by Article IV, section 11 and Article V, section 4 of the Constitution of Wisconsin, do amend Executive Order #147 (dated 6/18/92), which created the Governor's Commission on Dental Care to add the following language at 3(k):

1. Section 3(k) of Executive Order #147 shall be created to read:
"Identify and analyze the costs and benefits of restructuring Marquette Dental School as an independent dental school."
2. All other language of Executive Order #147 shall remain the same.
