EXECUTIVE ORDER #154

Relating to Gubernatorial Appointments

I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of this State, and specifically by Article IV, section 11 and Article V, section 4 of the Constitution of Wisconsin, do require the convening of a special session of the Legislature at the Capitol in Madison, beginning on September 15, 1992 solely to consider certain nominations for appointment by the Governor requiring confirmation by the Senate.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Wisconsin to be affixed. Done at the Capitol in the City of Madison this thirteenth day of August in the year one thousand nine hundred and ninety-two.
