EXECUTIVE ORDER #159

Proclamation of a State of Emergency

WHEREAS, a 10-year old female disappeared from The Town of Ripon, Wisconsin on August 23, 1992; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Ripon Police Department requested assistance from the Wisconsin National Guard, and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of this State, and specifically by Wisconsin Statute section 166.03.(1)(b)(1), do hereby:

Declare a State of Emergency, effective August 24, 1992, in Fond du Lac County and direct the Wisconsin National Guard and the Division of Emergency Government to assist state and local government agencies in taking whatever actions within the state that are necessary to aid in the search for said missing child.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Wisconsin to be affixed. Done at the Capitol in the City of Madison this the twenty-fourth day of August in the year one thousand nine hundred and ninety-two.
