EXECUTIVE ORDER #161

Proclamation of a State of Emergency and Order to
Limited Service of the Wisconsin National Guard

WHEREAS, heavy rains occurred in Wisconsin on September 14, 1992, causing flooding in Richland, Vernon, Columbia and Sauk Counties; and

WHEREAS, several areas of Richland County were evacuated and emergency shelter was required;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of this State, and specifically by Wisconsin Statute section 14.019, do hereby:

Declare a State of Emergency, effective September 14, 1992, in Richland County and direct the Wisconsin National Guard and the Division of Emergency Government to assist state and local government agencies in taking whatever actions within the state that are necessary to aid in the recovery of said flooding.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Wisconsin to be affixed. Done at the Capitol in the City of Madison this the fifteenth day of September in the year one thousand nine hundred and ninety-two.
