
Relating to General Obligation Bonds for the
State Fair Park Board and Appointment of Hearing Officer

WHEREAS, the State of Wisconsin (the "State") proposes to issue its General Obligation Bonds (the "Bonds") in an aggregate principal amount of not to exceed \$9,280,000, for the purpose of financing the national ice center; and


WHEREAS, Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, requires, as a condition of the exemption from federal income taxation of interest on the Bonds, that the issuance of the Bonds be approved by the State after a public hearing following reasonable public notice or by a referendum;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of the State of Wisconsin, do appoint the Secretary of the State of Wisconsin Building Commission or his delegatee (the "Hearing Officer") as hearing officer to hold a public hearing on the proposed issuance of the Bonds, following reasonable public notice, in accordance with the standards set forth in Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, and order the Hearing Officer to deliver to the Governor a transcript or summary of the appearances at that hearing.
