EXECUTIVE ORDER #169

Proclamation of a State of Emergency

WHEREAS, a 50-year old woman disappeared from Marshfield, Wisconsin on November 9, 1992; and


WHEREAS, the Marshfield Police Department requested assistance from the Wisconsin National Guard;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of this State, and specifically by Wisconsin Statute section 166.03 (1)(b)(1), do hereby:

Declare a State of Emergency, effective November 12, 1992, in Wood County and direct the Wisconsin National Guard and the Division of Emergency Government to assist state and local government agencies in taking whatever actions within the state that are necessary to aid in the search for said missing woman, including the use of a helicopter.



IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Wisconsin to be affixed. Done at the Capitol in the City of Madison this twelfth day of November in the year one thousand nine hundred and ninety-two.
