EXECUTIVE ORDER #170

Relating to Amending Executive Orders #2 & #109  
(dated 1/28/87 & 1/25/91) regarding the Governor's Advisory  
Council on Judicial Selection

I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, pursuant to sec. 14.019, Wis.Stats., do amend Executive Orders #2 (dated 1/28/87) and #109 (dated 1/25/91) sections three, four and five, respectively, which created and recreated the Governor's Council on Judicial Selection, as follows:

Section Three:

In the case of a vacancy on the Supreme Court, at least two additional members shall be appointed by the Governor upon consultation with the President of the State Bar; however, these members shall only serve until the Council makes its recommendation as to that vacancy;


Section Four:

In the case of a vacancy on the Court of Appeals, at least two additional members shall be appointed by the Governor from the Court of Appeals District in which the vacancy occurs; however, these members shall only serve until the Council makes its recommendation as to that vacancy;

Section Five:

In the case of a vacancy of the Circuit Court, the Chairperson of the Advisory Council shall appoint at least two additional members who reside in such circuit after consultation with the President of the local bar association or associations, as appropriate; however, these members shall only serve until the Council makes its recommendations as to that vacancy.


